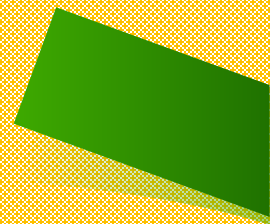


Back to School Plan

We are monitoring positivity rates in the three communities that we serve.

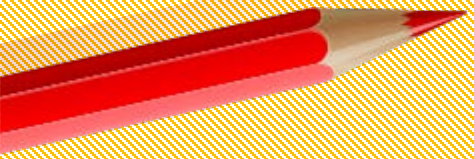

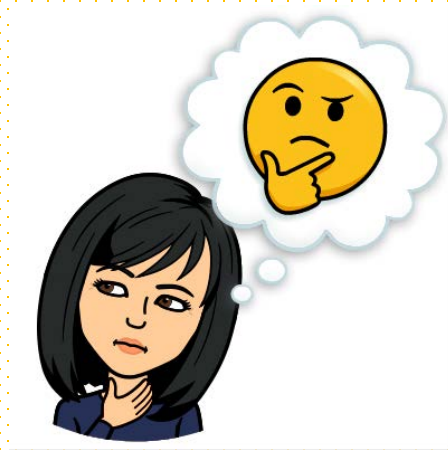




- ❖ The plan is consistent with Illinois State Board Education (ISBE)
- ❖ Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) and Illinois Department of Public Health (IDPH). Health and safety for students and staff are key considerations throughout the plan.
- ❖ Developed collaboratively with teachers, union leaders, and administrators working closely together.
- ❖ Built in flexibility including a remote learning option for students. It includes careful consideration as to how the entire plan pivots to remote learning if needed.



Key Considerations/ Core Ideas



- ❖ A combination of in person and remote learning provides the best opportunity for all students

- ❖ In person in the am and remote learning in the pm
 - *Less time for students to wear a mask*
 - *No lunch will be provided*

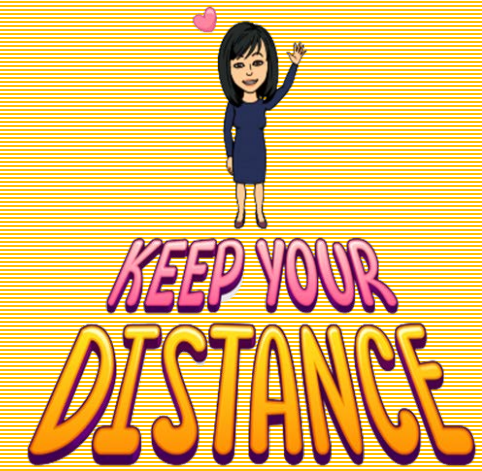
- ❖ *If a survey is not completed that student will be placed in full remote learning for the rest of the year*



Prioritization of Health and Safety



- ❖ Every school has a registered nurse and a health clerk
- ❖ Face masks are required for all.
- ❖ Daily self certification for all prior to entering the school building
 - Self-certification through the online application
 - Daily temperature checks will happen at the door before entering the building
 - Those experiencing symptoms must stay home and the school will need to be notified.
 - There will be a separate quarantine room for students who become sick while at school
- ❖ Posters and floor decals are posted throughout the building to mark and remind everyone of social distancing



Cont. Prioritization of Health and Safety

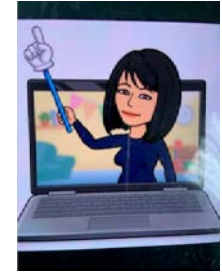


- ❖ Learning spaces have been arranged to accommodate the required distancing
- ❖ Students will not be switching classrooms, teachers will be rotating
- ❖ All students will have an individual transparent desk shield
- ❖ All rooms have touchless hand sanitization stations and additional stations are available throughout the building
- ❖ Buildings have been equipped with touchless water stations to fill water bottles



Cont. Prioritization of Health and Safety...

- ❖ Students that choose only remote instruction will continue to have access to all curriculum and instruction at home for the remainder of the year
- ❖ Detailed cleaning and disinfecting practices will continue as it has been implemented. Scheduled disinfecting of high touch surfaces (i.e. door knobs, stair railings, etc.)



- ❖ Hand washing and use of hand sanitizers will be required when exiting and entering classroom and at other times throughout the day as deemed necessary



- ❖ No sharing of instructional supplies and materials
